RE: Impeachment Hearing

Dear friends,

The NH House published an addendum to the House Calendar for this week: scheduling the public hearing on HR 41 - the impeachment bill against me - for **Friday, February 27 at 9:30am at Granite Place in Concord**. I am writing with an URGENT request for support:

1) SIGN IN ONLINE - **Can you please mobilize your networks to sign in against the bill electronically ASAP?** The clock has started ticking!

- Go to: <https://gc.nh.gov/house/committees/remotetestimony/default.aspx>.
- Put in your name, town, and email address,
- Click on 2/27 for the date,
- Select the "Judiciary Committee" from the drop-down menu, and then
- Select HR 41 from the next drop-down menu.
- Click on "I am a member of the public" representing "myself" and
- Select "I oppose this bill."

Numbers will help make the case that this bill is unpopular and not worth pursuing. We need thousands of people to do this.

2) IN-PERSON VISIBILITY - **Can you please send a delegation from your town/county committee to help with visibility on Friday, February 27 at Granite Place in Concord?** This will be 8:30-10am and will likely begin outside of the building and then move into the hallway inside. Handmade signs about free speech and democracy are encouraged! (Suggested options: Respect the Voters' Choice! Support Free Speech! Vote No on HR41! Let Voters Decide! AG Cleared Her! Don't Impeach! She's Been Cleared! Don't Waste Taxpayer Time & \$\$! Impeachment is Not the NH Way!). And please reply to this email if you are planning to attend so we can track internally!

I will be holding a zoom meeting on Wednesday at 5:30-6pm to give an update on plans for the public hearing. Please come if you can - and spread the word. All are welcome!
